

SMC Chapter 2.06, Lobbying Regulations

Employer Authorization

There is no form for employer authorizations. You can, however send a link of your Lobbyist Registration report to your employer/client for them to review.

Go to the Lobbying Disclosure Reports page at
<http://www2.seattle.gov/ethics/lobbyists/reports.asp>

Find the Client/Employer Registration report to be authorized. Click the Pop Up button. Scroll down to the bottom of the report and find:

Fixed link to this report: [\[a series of characters that identifies your report\]](#)

Right click on the link and select Copy Shortcut from the menu box. You can then Paste the shortcut to your report into a wordprocessing document or an email to your Employer/Client for them to review.

Your correspondence might include the following language:

I authorize [Lobbyist's Name] to lobby on [Employing Organization's] behalf. [Lobbyist Name] has registered as a Lobbyist for this purpose with the Client/Employer Registration report linked to here:
